### Graduate Diploma in Teaching (Primary)

The University of Auckland's year-long graduate diplomas in teaching are intensive programs designed to ensure you that when you graduate you will have the knowledge as well as the practical experience to begin your teaching career with confidence. You will receive plenty of opportunities to experience first-hand what it's like to work and teach in schools/centres and gain a sound understanding of what your future career will actually be like. Graduates of these programs are teaching in New Zealand, Canada and throughout the world.

### Graduate Diploma in Teaching (Secondary)

Qualifies you to teach your chosen curriculum subject(s) at secondary school level (typically age 13 to 18 year olds).  
 Note: To enter into this program you will need to have taken, as part of your undergraduate degree, sufficient courses in two subjects taught in New Zealand secondary schools.

### Graduate Diploma in Teaching (Primary)

Qualifies you to teach in primary (elementary) and intermediate (middle) schools (typically age five to 13 year olds).

## Start Dates/Orientation Dates

Secondary specialisation: Start late Feb/March  
 Primary specialisation: Start Jan or July (two intakes/year)  
 Semester One dates: Jan/March-June (depending on specialisation)  
 Semester Two dates: July-Nov/Dec  
 Orientation and introduction days are held at the beginning of each semester. A special orientation programme is also held for international students to help you adjust to your new home.
