REFEREES

You must supply the names and email contact details of two people who are willing to act as your referees. Your referees must not be family members, partners or close personal friends. If you are a school-leaver, one name should be from your school and the second one from another source. Examples of people who you could ask to act as a referee include:

- + The minister of your church
- + The principal of your school
- + The coach of your sports team
- + Your manager or supervisor at work
- + Someone who has been your teacher
- + A member of a committee on which you have served
- + An organiser of a charity for which you have worked
- + An organiser of a music or theatre event in which you have taken part
- + Someone who has taught or mentored you as part of industry training or further education

When we email the people you nominate, we will ask questions about whether they consider that you have the personal qualities needed to train successfully as a teacher.

We ask your referees if you have certain qualities such as: honesty and adaptability that would make you a good teacher; how sensitive you are to people from various backgrounds; and how well you generally get on with people.

Referees are an important part of our selection process. We cannot finalise your application until we have two email referee reports. Please ensure that we can contact your referees from the time you submit your application.
