Road closure notice – October 17th and 18th, 2026

*We would like to share with you that due to the **Toronto Waterfront Marathon** on October 17th & 18th, there is a road closure in the area that could have traffic impacts arriving or departing the hotel.*

The most significant closure which may impact you is **Bay St, between Dundas & Queen which will be closed from Saturday October 17th, 7am, until Sunday October 18th, 9pm, as this is located just outside our hotel.**

Guests who are driving are advised to go to the intersection of Bay & Dundas, which is half a block north of our hotel, and speak to a police officer who will be stationed at that intersection and can let you access the hotel.
